2024 End of Year Financial Update

As we approach the end of 2024, the Upper Midwest has received approximately \$310,000.00 in connectional giving and support.

For the year, we have spent around \$248,000 for our ministries. Giving us a difference of approximately \$62,000.00 for the year. We have much to thank God for!

This year we have been able to hold our Annual Conference, pay our tithe to our South Africa Partnership, send 16 delegates to General Conference in Costa Rica, sent a delegation to South Africa to support their annual conference, financially support disaster relief, continue to resource our leadership which serves our churches, and grow and implement more ministry teams and programs. We appear to be pretty close to our target budget across the board.

The Finance and Administration team will meet in January to review all the budget numbers and make adjustments as necessary to continue to meet the needs of the ministry work of the Upper Midwest Conference of the Global Methodist Church.



This foundational document serves as the church's governing polity, offering clear direction and guidance for our congregations as we embrace our mission and future together. A limited number of copies will be published and made available for purchase in the new year. Once they are ready, we will provide details on how to place an order.

Translations Are Underway!

To serve our global community, we are actively translating the Book of Doctrines and Discipline into the official languages of the Global Methodist Church. Producing accurate and high-quality translations is a detailed process that takes time, and we appreciate your patience as we work to make this resource accessible to everyone. Once completed, the translations will be uploaded to the website. Each new translation will be announced on our social media as it becomes available.

Effective Date and Transitional Guidance

Please note that the Book of Doctrines and Discipline will officially take effect on January 1, 2025. Until then, the Transitional Book of Doctrines and Discipline remains in effect and continues to guide our governance. This document is still accessible on our website for reference.

Judicial Practice and Procedures

We are also pleased to announce that the final version of the Judicial Practice and Procedures has been posted to the <u>website</u>. This document, adopted by the General Conference, is now in effect and functions as church law. It complements Part Nine of the Book of Doctrines and Discipline to govern the judicial processes stated therein.




